Establishment – Transport Department – Tamilnadu Ministerial serve Assistant to get promotion as Superintendent – Revision of Norms - orders – issued.

O R D E R

According to the provisions under the Tamil Nadu Minister service Rules, ans Assistant in the Transport Department has serve for four years in the following offices to qualify for appointment as Superintendent.

- a) One year as Assistant in the office of the Deputy Transport Commissioner or in the office of the Assistant Accounts Officer or in the State Transport Appellate Tribunal.
- b) Two years in the office of the State Transport Authority and
- c) One year as Accountant in any office in the Transport Department.

2. This is commonly known as Norms System. On further consideration, in the G.O.read above, an executive order was issued restricting the norms period. According to the said orders, the service period of Assistant in the State Transport Authority was reduced to one year, thereby bringing down the total norms period to 3 years. The Service period in other offices. However remained the same, The above orders were given effect to pending issue of amendment to the Tamilnadu Ministerial Service Rules. Government have proposed to issue amendments separately with retrospective effect from 9.7.1993 so as to regulate the appoint made based on the executive orders in the first G.O. read above.

3. In the year 1998, a committee was formed in the Transport Department to suggest ways and means to improve the efficiency the office of the Transport Commissioner. The Committee has that since the work in the Transport Commissioner's office very differs from that of Regional Transport Offices. The one year period for Assistant in Transport commissioner's official not just enough to learn the rudiments of working in the Commissionerate. The committee recommended that the period of norms of Assistant in the Transport commissioner's office may increased to two years.

4.The above recommendation of the official committee has been examined in consultation with the Transport Commissioner. The Transport Commissioner has suggested that the entire 'norms' prescribed for Assistants may be revised, as indicated below:-

1. Two years in the State Transport authority Deputy/ Joint Transport commissioner's office /State Transport Appellate Tribunal /assistant Accounts Officer/Audit)

2. One year as Accountant in any of the office of Regional Transport Office of the Transport Departments.

He has further suggested that the postings of the Assistants to Various norms post shall be done in the following orders according to seniority.

- i) State Transport Authority.
- ii) State Transport Appellate Tribunal.
- iii) Joint Transport commissioner, Chennai-17.
- iv) Deputy Transport Commissioners, and
- v) Assistant Accounts Officers (Internal Audit wing)

Besides, he has also suggested that the posting orders for norms post shall be centralized and issued from the Transport Commissioner office.

5.The Transport commissioner has further suggested that the recommendations referred to above shall be incorporated and issued in an executive order in view of urgency and amendment to Tamil Nadu Ministerial service Rules shall be issued in due course.

6.The Government after careful examination accept the recommendation of the Transport Commissioner regarding the service qualification prescribed in the post of Assistant for promotion as Superintendent. Accordingly the norms prescribed for Assistant shall be revised with the immediate effect as indicated below:

- (1) Two years in the state transport Authority, Deputy/Joint transport Commissioner's office/State Transport Appellate Tribunal /assistant Accounts Office (Audit).
- (2) One year as Accountant in any of the office of Regional Transport office of the Transport Department.
- (3) The postings of the Assistants to the various norms shall be done in the following orders according to seniority.

- i) State Transport Authority.
- ii) State Transport Appellate Tribunal.
- iii) Joint Transport commissioner, Chennai-17.
- iv) Deputy Transport Commissioners, and
- v) Assistant Accounts Officers (Internal Audit wing)

Nevertheless, it is always open to the Transport commissioner to post any of the Assistant in the offices even after completion of norms due to Administrative necessities.

7.Necessary amendments to the Tamilnadu Ministerial Service Rules shall be issued by the Personal and Administrative Reforms (Per.B) Department Separately.
