ORDER:

In G.O.Ms.No.1207, Home dt .30-08-1996, The Government have relegated the Regional Transport Authority powers in respect of a district (other than the district and city of Madras) to the collector concerned. Now the Transport Commissioner, Madras has reported that as the district and city of Madras has been excluded in the above notification, necessary orders may be issued reconstituting the Regional Transport Authority for District and city of Madras. The Government consider that existing arrangement that the (zonal) Deputy Transport commissioner Madras rested with Regional Transport Authority powers may be continued. The Government have therefore decided to amend the G.O.Ms.No.1207, Home dt .30-08-96.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 68 of the Motor vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 58 of 1988), the Governor of Tamil Nadu here by makes the following. Amendment to the Home Department Notification No.II(2) /HO/1835 (g) /96.Published at page 1 of part II –Section of the TamilNadu Government Gazette Extraordinary, dated 30th August 1996.

**AMENDMENT**

In the said Notification, the following expression shall be added at the end, namely:-

“and the Regional Transport Authority in the case of Madras district and the city of Madras shall be the (zonal) Deputy Transport commissioner, Madras.”
