The requisitions for police verification certificate/NOC regarding transfer of ownership of vehicle, Re-Registration of vehicle etc., on police point of view were being received repeatedly from all RTOs across the State. In this connection, it is informed that the Motor Vehicle Coordination System(MVCS) has been introduced by Nation Crime Records Bureau(NCRB) for enabling vehicle enquiry by public and police as well and that all India data base has been maintained in connection with the details of stolen/recovered vehicles and the same is made available in the NCRB website (<http://ncrb.nic.in/>) all over the State. Thereby, police can access the database by using username and password assigned and already communicated to the respective SPs and COPs.

2. Therefore, all SPs and COPs have been requested by sending circular to access the above database and issue police verification certificate/NOC to RTOs concerned in future so as to avoid delay and unnecessary correspondence in this regard.

3. A copy of the said circular is sent herewith with a request to communicate the same to all RTOs to take follow up action please.

Motor Vehicle Coordination System(MVCS) has been introduced by NCRB for enabling vehicle enquiry by public and police as well. All India data base has been maintained for stolen/recovered vehicles and the same is made available in the NCRB website (<http://ncrb.nic.in/>) all over the State. Thereby, police can access the database by using username and password assigned and already communicated to the respective SPs and COPs.

2. All SPs and COPs are requested to direct DCRBx/CCRBx concerned to access the NCRB database hereafter directly for making vehicle enquiry by using password/username so as to avoid delay in furnishing information to public/RTOs.

3. DCRBx/CCRBx will issue verification certificate/NOC on receipt of request from RTOs in the respective district or public. They are requested not to send such requisition to SCRIB in future.

Kindly refer to our earlier letter of even No. dated 26.12.2011 regarding the subject cited above.

NCRB has been receiving communications from Motor Vehicle Registering Authorities in various districts requesting for intimation u/s 62 of Central Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, whether any case of theft or crime is pending against any vehicle. It is also mentioned in these requests that if the relevant report is not received by the RTOs within 30 days, they would assign a new Registration No to the vehicle.

As you are aware, SCRIB also provides similar services through MV Verification Counters. It is, therefore, requested that such requests may be sent to these Counters so that prompt response is received. It may not be possible to accommodate these requests from individual RTOs due to quantum of such requests from all States/UTs.

Moreover, NCRB is in the process of implementing Crime & Criminal Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS) that includes module on Motor Vehicle Coordination. CCTNS will provide all relevant reports instantly and dynamically to the RTOs, with out sending any request to NCRB or SCRIB.

You are requested to direct all RTOs under your administrative control to observe the above guidelines in future so that the reports are available to the RTOs for quick disposal of cases and transfer of vehicles.
