Sub: Requesting immediate ban on usage of **multicolor dazzling head lights** by motor vehicle – reg.

Ref: Our Telegram dt. 27.6.2001.

We are disturbed by the recent phenomena of usage of multi coloured, dazzling headlights by some Motor vehicle owners. The headlights come in different colour such as orange, green, blue etc which very dangerously affects the visibility of on-coming vehicle drivers.

More and more motorists have started using this type of head lights bulbs in their vehicles without realizing the danger they pose to other motorists and also the fact that such act is in contravention of the Motor Vehicles act and rules, framed under the Act.

Therefore, there is an immediate and urgent need to initiate suitable action by the concerned agency on before the matter gets out of hand.

We suggest, that an immediate order be issued to the manufacturers and suppliers of such head light lamps to stop the manufacture and supply of such lamps and also to withdraw from the market the existing supplies. The retailers should also be instructed not to sell the above mentioned head light lamps.

A public notice may also be issued in this regard asking the erring motorists to immediately desist from using the above said multi coloured, dazzling head lamps in their vehicles. Special driver against such violators can also be conducted and penalty imposed.

We hope suitable corrective action would be initiated by your good self in this regard at the earliest.
