MOTOR VEHICLES – Stage Carriages – Renewal of Fitness Certificate – Exemption from rule 116 of the Tamil Nadu Motor vehicle rules 1989 for the state Transport Undertakings to obtain Fitness Certificate at the nearest Regional Transport Office/ Unit Office Tamil Nadu Motor vehicle Rules 1989 – Orders.

O R D E R

M/s. Jeeva Transport Corporation, Erode have represented that they are operating their buses from 16 depots in and around periyar District to Various places. The vehicles attached to the above depots are covered by permits issued by various authorities such as secretary, Regional Transport Authorities at Erodi, Namakkal, Tiruppur, Coimbatore and state Transport Authority, Madras. According to rule 116, M/s. Jeeva Transport Corporation has to send the vehicle attached to Karur Depot to Regional Transport Office, Erode issued by Regional Transport Authority, periyar District. This causes wastage of fuel. If they want to renewal the Fitness certificate at Regional Transport Office in Karur they have to obtain necessary permission from State Transport Authority, Madras as required under second provision to rule 116 of the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 to get the renewal of Fitness Certificate at Karur. This will also consume time. So M/s. Jeeva Transport Corporation have requested that vehicles belonging to state Transport Undertakings may be exempted from the provisions of the 116 of Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.

2. The Transport Commissioner has therefore recommended that,

- i) the motor vehicles belonging to State Transport Undertakings may be exempted from the provisions of rule 116 of the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Rules, so that the State Transport Undertakings can renew the Fitness Certificate of their vehicles at the nearest Regional Transport office. Or Unit office other than the region in which the permit for the vehicle has been issued, subject to the payment of an additional fee of Rs.50/- as required under rule 132 (3) of the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and production of current tax clearance certificate obtained from the authority which granted the permit and
- ii) all the state Transport Undertakings may be exempted from the provisions of rule 120 of the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicle Rules so that they can get fresh certificates of fitness to their vehicles after canceling the CFX notice from the nearest Regional Transport Office or Unit Office subject to the conditions laid down against item (1) above. The Transport Commissioner has stated that if the above two exemptions are granted to State Transport Undertakings it will enable them to save fuel, manpower, wear and tear of tyre etc.

3. The Government have carefully examined the proposal and consider that it would be sufficient to exempt the said vehicles from the first proviso to rule 116 of the said Rules and there is no need to exempt the said vehicles from rule does not provide that, only the authority in whose jurisdiction the permit has been issued can revoke CFX Notice and issue fresh certificate of fitness.

4. Under rule 131 of the Tamil Nadu Motor vehicles Rules, 1989, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the vehicles belonging to the state Transport Undertakings from the first proviso to rule 16 of the said rules, in so far as to enable the said Undertakings to make as application for the renewal of Certificate of fitness to the Registering or to the Motor Vehicles Inspector Grade-II, as the case may be, of a region other than the region in which the permit for the vehicle concerned has been issued, subject to payment of a fee of Rs.50/- as specified in the Table under rule 132 of the said Rules and on production on of Tax Clearance Certificate obtained from the authority which granted the permit.
